


## The Economic Impact of Teachers' Pensions in Georgia Teachers Retirement System of Georgia 404-352-6500 www.trsga.com








## IN FISCAL YEAR 2023:


- TRS paid **\$6 billion** to its retirees.
- 66,200 jobs in Georgia were supported by TRS retirees' pension income.
- TRS pension benefits contributed to \$8.3 billion in total economic output.

Each \$1 in state and local pension benefits paid to Georgia residents ultimately supports \$1.39\* in total output in the state.
